

## HERO WORLD SERIES 2020 REGULATIONS

The set of races **HERO WORLD SERIES 2020** is made up of 3 MTB Marathon races taking place in Dubai, Italy and Thailand.

### Men

HERO Dubai, UAE, 07 February 2020	60km 1,600hm
HERO Südtirol Dolomites, Italy, 20 June 2020	86km 4,500hm
HERO Thailand, Thailand 10 October 2020	62km 1,800hm

The 3 races are adding up a distance of 208 km and 7,900 hm.

### Women

HERO Dubai, Emirati Arabi Uniti, 07 febbraio 2020	60km 1,600hm
HERO Südtirol Dolomites, Italia 20 giugno 2020	60km 3,200hm
HERO Thailand, Thailand 10 ottobre 2020	62km 1,800hm

The 3 races are adding up a distance of 182 km and 6,600 hm.

### 1. CLASSES

OPEN MEN (Elite - Amateurs - Under23)

OPEN WOMEN (Elite - Amateurs - Under23)

### 2. REGISTRATION

Participants has to sign up online via Datasport website before 05 February 2020. Participants can subscribe to the package of 3 races with the following prices:

Early Bird entries until 30.06.2019	€ 290,00
From 01 July to 30 September 2019	€ 350,00
From 01 October to 31 October 2019	€ 380,00
From 01 November to 05 February 2020	€ 410,00

The starting blocks are established by each race according the UCI ranking. The amateurs will start from the first amateur starting block. The UCI delegate, with the agreement of the race chief and jury members, are allowed to change the starting order.

### 3. CLASSES AND RANKINGS

Ranking will be established according the following classes:

OPEN MEN (Elite - Under23 )

OPEN WOMEN (Elite - Under23 )

IMPORTANT: Only participants who have met the following requirements are considered for the ranking:

- Obligation to participate in all 3 races
- 3 results are required
- Acquisition of at least 300 points

Ranking points will be attributed according the following scoring scale:

200 for the 1st	110 for the 13th
180 for the 2nd	108 for the 14th
165 for the 3rd	106 for the 15th
155 for the 4th	96 for the 20th
146 for the 5th	76 for the 30th
138 for the 6th	62 for the 40th
131 for the 7th	52 for the 50th

120 for the 9th	32 for the 70th
116 for the 10th	22 for the 80th
114 for the 11th	12 for the 90th
112 for the 12th	2 for the 100th

The allocation of UCI points is linked to the ranking achieved in each race. At the end of the 3 races set, the leader will be the one with more points. Beyond the 100th place, the participant scores 1 point.

The prize giving ceremony will be held after the last stage, HERO Thailand, on 10 October 2020. In case of draw, the best ranking at the last race will determine the leader.

Participation to HERO World Series 2020 implies each competitor's respect of the rules of each race, the national cycling union's rules and the UCI's rules.

### 4. PRIZE

Every class leaders receive the HERO World Series 2020 jersey. For the ELITE - UNDER 23 class, the ten first will be rewarded with cash prizes according the following scale:

The first three of the AMATEUR MEN/WOMEN class will receive a prize in kind.

## 5. PROTESTS

Possible protests must be lodged with the jury at the same time, according to the regulations of the UCI and the FFC.

## 6. EVENT CANCELLATION

The organization committee reserves the right to modify the rules, the routes or the number of positive ascent at any time when circumstances require. The event will be held no matter the weather conditions as long as competitor's security is guaranteed. If the race has to be cancelled in the event of a reason beyond the organization's control, the registration will not be reimbursed or postponed to next year. Details will be given on event's website as well as during the race.

## 7. MODIFICATIONS

The organization committee reserves the right to modify the rules, at any time when circumstances require. The website of the event is the official source of information. Every official information will be communicate on the website of the event.

## 8. RESPONSIBILITY

Mountain biking in general and mountainbiking competitions in particular represent a physical activity which involves risks. Each participant must enter the race knowing that he will ride on mountainous terrain with steep climbs and rapid descents and doing it on his own responsibility. Registration implies that participants give up asserting their rights against the organization and against every natural or legal person involved in the event. Moreover, with the registration participants prove their good physical conditions to assume a great effort.

## 9. ADDITIONAL PROVISION

For every case that is not mentioned in the present regulations, FCI and UCI rules will be the reference

## 10. REGISTRATION

Registration implies that participants confirm:

- in case of disqualification, to have a medical certificate according ministerial decree 18.02.82; besides, the organization do not accept any responsibility in case of accident or helalth issue
- To have an license issued by a federation authorizing them to take part in cycling competitions
- To have a civil liability insurance
- To have read and accepted the present Regulations

## 11. DATA PROTECTION

By sending the online registration form, the competitor must declare to have carefully read and unconditionally accepted the regulations of the HERO World Series 2020 as published on the website [www.heroworldseries.com](http://www.heroworldseries.com), in all its parts. In relation to the information referred to in art. 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016, the competitor must declare that he or she has read the said information published on the website [www.heroworldseries.com](http://www.heroworldseries.com) and that he or she has been informed that consent to its processing for the purposes indicated in art. 2) of the above information is mandatory' by selecting the appropriate box on the registration form (for the purposes of processing personal data), and knowing that failure to consent to the processing of data for the purposes indicated in art. 2) of the information, will make it impossible to register for the activity in question.

With consent to the processing of personal data, the competitor expressly authorises the company that data can be transmitted and processed by third parties. The data must be complete and legible, also for insurance purposes. With the consent to the processing of their personal data the competitor expressly authorises the Company, so that its data be transmitted and processed by third parties that offer related services or services connected to the organisation, and as for example the delivery and or sending of gadgets purchased by the competitor, those for the purpose of timing, drawing up, announcing and publishing results on the website, and those for the purpose of photographing or filming the competitor.

According to art. 4 of EU Regulation 679/2016, processing means "any operation or set of operations, performed with
