

THE 2024 HERO ABU DHABI HUDAYRIYAT ISLAND: PETER SAGAN AND OTHER CHAMPIONS

The air is buzzing with excitement at the prospect of the first edition of the HERO Abu Dhabi Hudayriyat Island – even more so after receiving confirmation of the starting list. The event will take place on 11 February 2024 and has attracted a well-known crowd from the international XCO landscape. They will all compete on the circuit of the island's facility with a view of qualifying for the 2024 Paris Olympic Games.

The first edition of the **HERO Abu Dhabi Hudayriyat Island** sponsored by **Modon** will take place between 9 and 11 February 2024. This weekend will be a celebration of everything mountain bike, a tempting call for many renowned elite athletes. Their goal? The XCO Class 1 race, which will net them many important points to qualify for the 2024 Olympic Games in Paris.

The only UCI mountain bike in the Middle East will see a good **21 countries** kick off from the starting line, representing the best of the best in the world of XCO. All cyclists will be competing against one another on **Sunday**, **11 February**, on the Trail X track on Hudayriyat Island in Abu Dhabi.

Among all of the confirmed participants, one name stands out: three-time Road Cycling Champion **Peter Sagan**, who was never shy about his Olympic podium ambitions in the discipline which, after having stepped down from road cycling, will see his debut in the elite category.

THE HEROES

The Men's starting list of Cross-country Olympic boasts a good 14 national champions and three continental champions: David Campos for Europe, Ben Oliver for Australia, and Philip Buys for Africa.

The Women's starting line is just as impressive, with Italy's reigning XCO champion Martina Berta joining the starting tanks, already boasting a World XCO title for 2023. Joining her is Sofie Pedersen from Sweden, current European Under23 XCO champion, and seven-time Norwegian XCO Ingrid Jacobsen, champion and ready for her season debut. She says: "I am really looking forward to be visiting and racing in Abu Dhabi. It will be my first race of the season, and I think it is going to be a lot of fun!"

Giving them a good run for their money will be UCI World Series Champion Lejla Njemčević, ready for her second HERO adventure, and **Rebecca Henderson** from Australia.

Henderson states: "The opportunity to come to race in Abu Dhabi is really exciting for me. My initial plan was to stay in Australia for the entire summer however this opportunity came up and I couldn't refuse. It will be my first race of 2024 so I go there without expectations and only opportunities. I'm excited to visit UAE for the first time after flying through so many times and to get the 2024 season started!"
